

WELCOME TO SANDRA OLGARD'S STUDIO OF DANCE

Please find below the schedule/tuition for **2018/19**. Please enroll early to assure placement. Classes begin **Wednesday, Sept. 5th**. The classes are based on 9-week quarters, beginning Sept 5th and ending May 20th. The studio address is 304 W. 7th, on the corner of Bernard and 7th Ave, near Sacred Heart Hospital. To assure placement, please complete the Registration Form and Liability Release (scroll to the 3rd page & print) with a \$50.00 deposit per child. Please mail to Sandra Olgard at 8122 N. Panorama Dr. Spokane, WA 99208 (secure mailbox), or if a current student, you may place in the tuition box inside the studio. The \$50.00 includes a \$15.00 non-refundable registration fee and a \$35.00 recital fee per child. The recitals will then have free admission. Tuition is due with the first lesson of each quarter. Parent watching day is the first lesson of each month, excluding Sept., Jan. and May.

Pre-Ballet is for 3 and 4 yr olds. I am at the studio at 2:45 pm if necessary to allow parents who need to pick up siblings. The student must be 5 as of Sept. 1st for Pre-Primary; Primary for age 6 or older, Grade 1 for 7 yrs and older, etc, which is the Royal Academy of Dance (English) method that our studio is based on. It is very beneficial from Gr. 1 on, to take 2 times a week, especially if the student is planning on taking an RAD exam; taking 2x/weekly is highly recommended at Gr. 2 and **required** for Gr. 3 students. The student needs to take **3x/weekly** by Gr. 5. I welcome Gr 4 students, if taking 3 ballet classes per wk, to add a Gr. 5 class. Modern is offered for Gr 4/5/IF and Inter/Adv students. Tap and Jazz is offered for all ages. It was recommended to teachers that students remain at Inter Foundation & Intermediate level each, for 2 years to obtain the standard they expect. Therefore, Inter Foundation should be for the Jr High student and Inter for the high school student. Level for Pointe Class will be dependent on strength and ability and placement will be by our teachers. Our excellent teachers are Ann Eldore (ballet), Lauren Bray (ballet), Ryann Fencl (ballet pointe & modern), Kate Cornwall (modern/tap/jazz), and myself for ballet. The schedule is subject to change due to enrollment. There will be a \$5 late fee per lesson if classes are not paid on time, so please mark your calendars with the quarter payments. Classes may change due to enrollment. Thank you!

DRESS CODE: The ballet leotard & character skirt may be purchased on line from the Royal Academy of Dance www.radusa.com or similar leo locally from the Empire Dance Shop, 131 S. Sherman between 2nd and Pacific Ave. For tights, jazz pants, etc some items may be purchased online through Discount Dance. If so please use our studio number of 32920 to give the studio credit. Please do not buy the ballet slippers from Payless Shoes because the soles are too firm and do not help or flatter the child's foot when pointed.

Girls: All girls must have their hair in a bun. It is for discipline, line and the ability to move & see. Pre Ballet, Pre-Primary & Primary: **Pink** ballet tights or anklet socks, pink full sole ballet slippers, sleeveless pink leotard with pink skirt. Grades 1 & 2: Sleeveless (tank) **Purple/lilac** leotard with matching elastic belt, pink anklets or tights, pink full sole ballet slippers with elastic, character skirt & shoes. To make full circular char skirt, purchase black heavy cotton material Yardage: (approx age 7, 8) 1 7/8 yds; (age 9 - 12) 2 1/2 yds; add an extra 1/4 yd if tall, above 12 yrs 3 1/3 yds **OR** order from New York, Lilly's Creation www.characterskirt.com or email lilly@characterskirt.com., approx \$48 **OR** Empire Dance Shop is carrying for the older children (ie Gr. 5 – 8); Grades 3, 4 & 5: Sleeveless navy blue tank leotard with matching elastic belt, pink tights, pink full sole ballet slippers with elastic, character skirt and shoes. (read above for skirt info.) Intermediate Foundation, Inter. & Advanced: Black camisole leotard, pink tights, full sole ballet slipper w/ ribbons, pointe shoes. For exams, shankless pointe shoes needed for Inter & Adv exam students.

Boys: Pre-Ballet - Grade 2: White tank or short sleeve leotard with black bike shorts. White ballet slippers and white anklets. Character/jazz shoes for Grade 1 & up. Grade 3 & up: Same as boys above but with Boy's black tights/leggings. Tank leotard for major male dancers.

Jazz/Tap: Black tap/jazz shoes, black jazz pants and appropriate top or leotard of choice.
